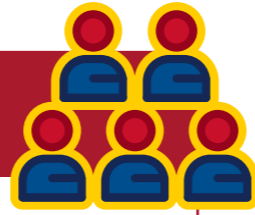


A GUIDE TO HAPPY TRAFFIC AT SAS



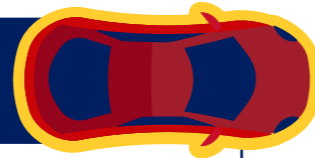
As a very large school of over 4,000 students and staff arriving everyday, smooth logistics and a common set of traffic rules and expectations are essential for safety and wellbeing for all.

Community Traffic Expectations



- Be kind!
- The security and safety team is working for the safety and well being of all, please support them to help their directions and instructions to keep everyone safe.
- Please stay in your vehicle during pickup and dropoff.
- Observe the campus speed limit of 20km/h
- Inline with the national law on vehicle idling, Please remember to switch off your engines when stationary

Car



Students who will be dropped off or picked up via car will follow specific precautions to ensure we maintain safe distancing. To help with this process, every student at SAS will receive a car dropoff/pickup assignment. This ensures that if your child needs to be picked up via car instead of walking or riding the bus, they will be able to follow the same procedure as everyone else.

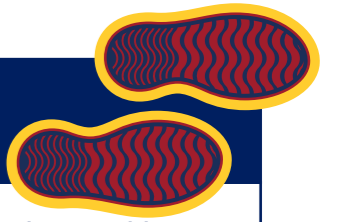
Morning Dropoff

- Cars may not enter campus for dropoff until 7:30 a.m.
- Parents must stay in their cars during the dropoff process
- Cars must have an SAS decal on their window in order to access campus. Private hire/ Grab/taxis will not be permitted on campus until after 8:05 a.m.

Afternoon Pickup

- Cars will not be allowed on campus until 3:30 p.m. Please ensure that you come during your designated pickup time. You will not be able to enter campus before your pickup time.
- The pickup times are scheduled as follows:
 - At 3:30 p.m. students with last names A-L will be dismissed
 - At 3:40 p.m. students with last names M-Z will be dismissed
 - At 4:00 p.m. we will allow private hire/ Grab/taxis onto campus

Walk



Students who walk to campus can access three gates; the east gate located by our elementary school, the main gate at the front of campus, and the middle school gate located across from our middle school and high school.

Morning Dropoff

- Students who walk will not be allowed to enter campus until 7:30 a.m.
- Students from third grade to twelfth grade will need to say goodbye to their parents at the gate
- Parents with students from preschool to second grade may enter campus to drop their child off at their division lobby. Kindergarten, first, and second grade students will be dropped off in elementary school lobby A. Early learning center students will be dropped off at the early learning center lobby.

Afternoon Pickup

- At 2:55 p.m. kindergarten - second grade parents may come onto campus to meet their child and walk them home.
- At 3:17 p.m. all remaining elementary school, middle school, and high school walkers will be dismissed to walk home.

Bus



For nearly three-quarters of Singapore American School students, the school day starts and ends with a trip on a school bus. Yeap Transport has been our trusted bus service provider since 1993. The bus is one of the most efficient ways to arrive and depart from campus each day.

Morning Dropoff

- As students arrive they will be asked to go directly to their classroom.

Afternoon Pickup

- Bus riders will be dismissed in two phases beginning at 3:00 p.m. to help avoid large crowds.
- Buses will depart SAS at 3:15 p.m.

To help with the flow of traffic we encourage you to consider dropping off/picking up your child from these locations off campus.
